

Museums are often seen as places that put creativity on display, whether that is art, science, or history. Hudson River Museum is all that and more—a powerful engine of human achievement and social progress, offering people of all backgrounds opportunities to make, learn and collaborate, and make positive change together. I am thrilled that you have joined us tonight as we share our expanded views.

2022 HONOREE

THE BERNACCHIA FAMILY AND LIBERTY LINES

The Bernacchia family moved to Yonkers in 1925, and they have been serving the Westchester community as multi–generational contributors ever since. Arthur and George Bernacchia became involved in the family business in 1953. They renamed their father's company, Bernacchia Brothers Inc., to Liberty Coaches, and during the coming decades they would expand the company, now known as Liberty Lines Transit, based in Valhalla, to include several other local bus companies.


Arthur and George, along with their partner Ray Murphy, further developed their family business and built a nationally recognized transit system that flourishes to this day. The company covers 60 separate routes serving 27 million passengers a year, operates 96% of Westchester County's Bee-Line Bus system in a public-private partnership, and employs over 700 people.

Arthur Bernacchia (1928–2017) attended Yonkers schools and graduated from Gorton High School. He attended Colgate University, graduating with honors in 1950. Arthur served two years in the Army after graduating, as a logistics specialist stationed in France from 1951-1952. After returning to Yonkers in 1953, he met the love of his life, June Breimann. The two married in 1955 and were together for almost 62 years. Together, they had five children and nine grandchildren. Arthur is survived by his wife, June Breimann Bernacchia, and children Bruce Bernacchia and his wife Carol, of Dobbs Ferry; Janet Wilkins and her husband Robert, of Somers; Brian Bernacchia and his wife Maureen, of Yonkers; Jeanmarie Kuck and her husband Brad, of Mahopac; and David Bernacchia and his wife Lisa, of Pound Ridge. Bruce Bernacchia is the Managing Director of the Liberty Lines Board of Directors, along with Gerard Bernacchia and Joe Murphy Bruce has also served on the Board of Trustees at the Hudson River Museum since 2011.

In addition, for more than 25 years, the Bernacchia family has contributed to Westchester's dynamic dining scene with their series of upscale and garden-to-table Italian restaurants in Westchester and Montauk, NY. In 1994, Bruce, along with Angelo Liberatore, opened their first restaurant together, Harvest on Fort Pond in Montauk. In 1998, what began as an abandoned piece of property developed into Harvest on Hudson, a forward-thinking riverfront restaurant in Hastings-on-Hudson that has since been named among the "10 Best Waterfront Restaurants in Westchester" by *Huffington Post*. Sustainable gardening practices have been a hallmark from the beginning, featuring herbs and vegetables all started from seed and hand planted in the garden's nutritious soil. The Half Moon restaurant was opened in 2008 on the Hudson in Dobbs Ferry.

A favorite memory of the Bernacchia family involves the Hudson River Museum. In 1969, Bruce and his cousin Gerard were encouraged by Bruce's mother June to head down to the Museum to see what was new. Their timing was impeccable—it turned out to be opening day of the HRM's brand new Planetarium and the boys were the very first visitors to test out the state-of-the-art astronomy equipment! They have been looking upwards ever since.

2022 HONOREE

YONKERS IDA

Established in 1982, Yonkers IDA (YIDA) works to create economic development and job growth throughout the City of Yonkers by attracting new businesses, retaining existing ones, and helping them all become more competitive in a global marketplace.

Since 2019, the YIDA has provided financial incentives to development projects representing a total private investment of approximately \$1.48 billion. The developments are projected to create approximately 3,259 new residential units and approximately 3,365 construction, full-time and part-time jobs. Ten percent of all new residential units are set aside for affordable housing. YIDA's efforts have ensured the continued economic and cultural revitalization of the City of Yonkers, with increased possibilities for housing, tourism, and new business.

In 2021, the YIDA provided financial incentives to residential and commercial projects representing a total private investment of more than \$508 million. The developments are projected to create 1,009 new residential units and more than 1,739 construction jobs. Recent projects include Hudson Piers, Extell Development's mixed-use community with more than 1,400 luxury and affordable apartments, exciting retail, and a new riverfront esplanade along a prime waterfront location with beautiful views of the Hudson River across to the Palisades. The project will be constructed in three phases over the next six years.





2022 HONOREE

ARTIST JAMEL ROBINSON

Jamel Robinson is a painter, sculptor, writer, and performance artist based in Harlem, New York. His artwork addresses the Black lived experience in America and his personal experience navigating life's challenges. Robinson began his artistic journey as a poet and taught himself to paint to further his range of expression. Over the past ten years, he has evolved an individual style of abstraction, and in 2018, he began applying the paint directly with his hands and manipulating it with squeegees. Working predominantly on the floor, in a bent position of surrender, the paintings are a way he has processed personal struggles, but are also an area of openness and discovery. The process is physical. While many of his works are abstract, it's impossible to ignore the presence of the body, *his* body, and the intended viewer.

Robinson has been working closely with the HRM over the past two years, first as the impactful fall 2021 Teaching Artist-in-Residence; a teaching artist and poet at Enrico Fermi School in Yonkers, NY, through a dedicated School Violence Prevention partnership for our youth. The artist made his museum debut at HRM in *Jamel Robinson: Beauty from Ashes* in 2021. The exhibition caught the attention of major media and was prominently featured in *The New York Times* and on *CBS News*. Soon after, he garnered further art world attention with a successful solo exhibition at A Hug for the Art World in Chelsea.

Robinson's work has been featured in several solo gallery exhibitions, including at the Established Gallery and the Ivy Brown Gallery in New York and the Gallery Von Schmordenfaden in Copenhagen, Denmark. In 2018, his work was featured in 100 Works, curated by Derrick Adams, Oshun Layne, Larry Ossei-Mensah, Teriha Yaegashi, Stephanie Cunningham, Gabriel de Guzman, and Becky Elmquist and presented by ARTNOIR, LatchKey Gallery, and E+. His work was recently on view in *The Eyes Have It* at the Lehman College Art Gallery and at The Meeting Point, a pop-up gallery curated by Danny Baez in collaboration with ARTNOIR, REGULARNORMAL, and The Meatpacking District.
